



Promise Academy Continuity Plan 2021-2022

Academic Programming

Promise Academy will return to in-person learning in August of 2021. There will be no remote learning option after that time, unless the school is forced to close due to COVID related issues, in which case the school's Remote Learning Plan will be implemented. Students are expected to attend school in-person, on a daily basis.

As referenced above, Promise Academy has a Remote Learning Plan that will be implemented should the school have to close due to COVID related issues. Promise will engage all learners virtually and will ensure that each students has sufficient remote access to continue making academic progress. If the Remote Learning Plan is activated, the students will be able to access their course work from home via Edgenuity. ELA team will meet on a weekly basis to discuss progress, results and challenges.

Operations/ Health Safety

All students will be expected to arrive on campus at the required school start time. All student, staff, faculty and teachers are asked to review the daily covid screening checklist and take their own temperature before arriving at school. If anyone has a temperature or has Covid-19 symptoms, they are requested to stay home.

Masks are required in the building as all times beside designated mask break areas. This is a requirement for all whether or not a person is or is not vaccinated. Please refer to mask policy for more detail.

Handwashing will be encouraged throughout the day. Labs will be set up with proper social distancing.

The LEA team will follow CDC and the Cleveland Department of Public Health's guidance on all Covid related decisions and strategies.

Promise Academy will follow the CDPH's required protocol to report Covid cases within the school.

We have established a designated area near the front lobby to isolate a person in the event of someone getting sick on campus while they are waiting for transportation home. We are also in close contact with the Cleveland Department of Public Health to

help determine any circumstances that may require extra attention such as reported COVID-positive cases and possible exposures to staff and students.

The Director of Operations will continue to participate in the CDPH weekly meetings. This will ensure the school is up to date and practicing the recommended safety guidance.

The school will be cleaned and disinfected daily by Coverall cleaning company. Disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizers will be made available throughout the day to mitigate potential virus spread.

Communication and Family Support

Promise Academy maintains an all call system through Education Connection through which the school can quickly and efficiently contact all parents, students, faculty and stakeholders through voice and text. This system is used to notify specific groups or the whole school of important information, or to point them to the school website for additional information. At enrollment, parents and students will be advised of the importance of maintaining correct phone and address information in the Student Information System. The Director of Operations (DOO) will be responsible for sending out these messages. In the event the DOO is unable to send out the messages the Principal will be responsible for the messages.

The school also maintains a website which holds information on school events and procedures and can and will be used as a centralized information board.

Promise Academy will employ an engagement associate to reach out to families. This person will help in identifying and mitigating barriers to academic success.

Technology

Students will be using an online platform called Edgenuity for learning. If the school is shut down do to outbreak, the students will be able to continue working on their coursework. All teachers will also have a zoom account so they are able to conduct lessons online if necessary. Lastly, we have installed large monitor's to connect to each of the lab chromebooks to help promote social distancing.
