BACKGROUND

Promise Academy is a non-traditional charter high school offering scholars ages 15 through 21 in 9th through 12th grade an alternative, and often accelerated, opportunity to earn their high school diploma.

Promise's mission is to provide the highest quality of education in Ohio for the non-traditional scholar in accordance with the highest traditions and principles of public-school education. Promise Academy is dedicated to the concepts of innovation, excellence, academic achievement, and opportunity for all scholars regardless of life circumstances. Our vision is to ensure the academic success of the non-traditional scholar by treating each scholar with dignity and providing on-line and off-line educational opportunities that will enhance academic achievement. Promise Academy also aims to offer scholars a full range of wrap-around services that assist young adults to self-regulate in relationship to school, work, and sometimes parenting. Our big goal is to link scholars with educational experiences that will connect them to a college and/or a career, opening up a choice-filled life.

THE OPPORTUNITY

Instruction at Promise Academy is primarily delivered via a personalized learning system. Teachers are responsible for understanding student needs, monitoring student success with the curriculum and credit accumulation, intervening to support in advancing student understanding and efficient credit accumulation--providing in-person one-on-one or small group instruction and offline assignments as applicable--and fostering a warm learning environment to support student success. We are looking for a certified Intervention Specialist who is passionate about Promise's students and will invest heavily in them over the course of the students' time at Promise Academy and be champions of their high school graduation and their ongoing success.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop productive teacher-student relationships to support re-engaging students in the academic experience
- Diagnose and understand student academic needs and associated credit needs to support effective instruction and efficient credit accumulation
- Provide active management of the daily student learning experience, anticipating barriers, and intervening to support and advance student understanding before students reach a frustration point
- Manage student IEPs to ensure student needs are being met and goals are being accomplished
- Monitor students overall progress developing and delivering interventions and support building understanding and course completion
- Develop and maintain effective communication pathways with students, to support the ongoing student learning experience, and to effectively troubleshoot academic, attendance, or engagement issues; regularly communicate with students outside of the lab via phone, email, etc.



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- Collaborate with other faculty and school leaders to address the academic and social emotional needs of all of Promise's students, including to support the implementation of student IEPs
- Serve as the primary person for a cohort of students to provide overall oversight of the students' learning experience ensuring their engagement, success, graduation from Promise Academy, and identification of appropriate post-secondary pathways; work with faculty across content areas to gain a full picture of students' academic status and allow for a student-centered communication approach

- Preferred two-plus years of teaching experience in an urban public school or charter school
- Experience in working in or with personalized learning systems, comfort delivering and/or directing online content
